



Purpose

It shall be the principal purpose of the organization to meet, greet, and otherwise act as official host and goodwill ambassadors on behalf of the City of Snyder, Scurry County and the Snyder Chamber of Commerce.

To aid and promote the community and the Snyder Chamber of Commerce as it undertakes the task of improving the area's quality of life through the development and stimulation of interest in the areas of economic and social potential.

To cooperate with and support the Snyder Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors in any function deemed necessary and appropriate.

Meetings

Regular meetings shall be held quarterly at a convenient time and location to be designated by the President or Vice President. Verbal notification or electronic notification shall be given to each member at least one week prior to the day for such meeting.

The meetings shall be conducted according to the latest revision of the Roberts Rules of Order. It shall in any event be necessary for a simple majority quorum vote to cause an action to be official. A quorum is further defined as being a simple majority of the Executive Committee plus two Gold Coat members. Members have the right to cast votes by proxy as described under Robert's Rules of Order.

Membership

Membership in the organization will be drawn from the roll of active members of the Chamber of Commerce and the total number of Gold Coats will be a maximum of 55. Failure to pay Chamber dues will be cause for acceptance of the person's resignation or, upon a plurality vote of the members at a regular meeting; said members name will be removed from the roll.

New membership affiliation will be by invitation or application. Voting on a prospective new member may be done electronically by the membership. Invitations must be made in writing and submitted to the nominating committee.

Members are expected to remain active in the organization's affairs. If a member does not attend a work activity for six consecutive months, he/she will automatically be removed from the membership roster. (A work activity is to be defined as any functions other than a ribbon cutting or monthly meetings). If he/she does not subsequently become active and participate in any work activity for six more months, mitigating circumstance accepted, his resignation will be accepted.

A member upon attainment of 65 year of age and who has been a member for 10 years may become a member emeritus at which time he/she will be exempted from the attendance requirements set in Article X, Section 3. Honorary members shall have the same status as a member emeritus.
